Case of Liu Ping – denial of access to medical treatment

Your Excellency

By this letter, I would like to indicate that I am very worried about the case of **Liu Ping** who is detained in Jiangxi Nanchang Women's Prison. She is a Prisoner of conscience since she was detained solely for her activism in New Citizen's Movement. **Liu Ping** said that she was suffering from chronic diarrhoea and stomach upset but was not given a medical examination or treatment. Her daughter was not allowed to ask **Liu Ping** about her health during visits but she said she looked pale and thin.

I am calling on you to immediately and unconditionally release **Liu Ping** and I demand that she is given immediate access to an independent medical examination and any treatment she needs. Furthermore I am urging you to ensure she is protected from torture and other ill-treatment.
